

BOWLING RULES

1. General provisions

- 1.1. The bowling area is intended for safe, orderly and enjoyable leisure activities for all visitors.
- 1.2. Visitors must follow the instructions of staff and comply with these rules.
- 1.3. Management reserves the right to refuse service to anyone who does not comply with the rules or disturbs other visitors.

2. Footwear and equipment

- 2.1. Only special bowling shoes are permitted.
- 2.2. Street shoes are not permitted on the lanes.
- 2.3. Equipment must be used with care and in accordance with its intended purpose.
- 2.4. It is prohibited to throw balls outside the lane, throw them against the screen, sit on the lane or damage the equipment.

3. Safety

- 3.1. Before throwing, check that other players are at a safe distance.
- 3.2. Running, pushing or dangerous behaviour in the bowling area is prohibited.
- 3.3. Children under the age of 12 may only play under adult supervision.
- 3.4. Standing behind the technical barriers on the lanes is prohibited.
- 3.5. Sitting on the technical barriers is prohibited.
- 3.6. The next throw may only be made once the balls have completely returned to the holder.
- 3.7. It is strictly forbidden to throw balls with the barrier closed, before starting the game or after finishing it.
- 3.8. If too many balls accumulate in the holder and the system emits a signal, the balls must be placed in the lower holder.

4. Animals

- 4.1. Animals are not permitted on the bowling alley premises, except if they are inside special bags or trolleys.
- 4.2. It is strictly forbidden to leave animals on the floor or sit them on chairs.

5. Behaviour, food and drinks

- 5.1. Visitors must behave respectfully and considerately towards other players.
- 5.2. Persons who are clearly intoxicated may be refused entry to the game.
- 5.3. It is prohibited to bring in your own food or drinks, except for cakes.
- 5.4. If the customer brings a cake, a charge of EUR 2.50 per person will be applied for the cake service.

6. Reservations and payments

- 6.1. The game is paid for according to the current price list.
- 6.2. The reservation time begins at the agreed time, regardless of delays.
- 6.3. The administration has the right to cancel the reservation if the delay exceeds 15 minutes.

7. Liability for damage

- 7.1. Visitors are liable for damage caused to equipment intentionally or through negligence.
- 7.2. Full compensation may be claimed for any damage.

8. Final provisions

- 8.1. In the event of non-compliance with the rules, the administration may interrupt the game without refunding the money.
- 8.2. The rules come into force from the moment of their publication.
